# Who can apply to go abroad and get a scholarship?

- First Stage / Graduate Students (the exchange can take place during the second or third year of studies)
- Second Stage Students (Graduate Students)
- PhD Students (Postgraduate Students)

# Who can apply?

An Erasmus+ SMS scholarship may be allocated to all UW students (irrespective of nationality and subject to the provisions of art.12) who are enrolled in a full-time or part-time degree programme leading to a diploma at bachelor, master or doctoral level (including participants of Doctoral Schools) or students enrolled in long-cycle master degree programmes excluding first-year students of bachelor programmes (subject to the provisions of art. 3) and students of the last year of master programmes and last year of doctoral studies (including participants of Doctoral Schools) as well as students of postgraduate programmes.

# Who can apply?

In exceptional and justified cases first-year bachelor students may be selected for an Erasmus+ mobility (e.g. within the framework of studies conducted jointly with a partner university on the basis of an additional cooperation agreement). In such exceptional cases the Selection Committee shall include justification of their choice in the Selection Outcome Report (Protokół Kwalifikacji) and the students will be entitled to the Erasmus+ scholarship provided their GPA after the first year of studies reaches at least 3,49.



# Who can apply?

In exceptional and justified cases first-year bachelor students may be selected for an Erasmus+ mobility (e.g. within the framework of studies conducted jointly with a partner university on the basis of an additional cooperation agreement). In such exceptional cases the Selection Committee shall include justification of their choice in the Selection Outcome Report (Protokół Kwalifikacji) and the students will be entitled to the Erasmus+ scholarship provided their GPA after the first year of studies reaches at least 3,49.

Important: for first-year BA students, only the second semester is available!

# Who can apply?

Third-year bachelor students may be awarded an Erasmus+ scholarship, provided that prior to the mobility they enroll in master studies in the same field of study at UW. Third-year bachelor students may only be awarded a mobility at the host university to be carried out in the second semester of the first year of their master programme.

Important: only the second semester is available for these students!

## **Who can apply? (an important exception)**

First-grade undergraduate students: you cannot apply in the first turn of qualification (since you do not have a year-span GPA yet).

However: you can apply in autumn to get a scholarship for the second semester of your second year of studies.

# How to apply?

- Applications should be submitted via USOSweb (requested by BWZ i EWP)
- But, nevertheless, we kindly ask to send e-documents to Anna Szpilowska:

- The mobility offer (Universities, Stages, the Length of Mobility) will be available in USOSweb
- When you apply you can choose one to three universities (the order should reflect your preferences)
- Priviledged applicants:
  - Handicapped persons (confirmed by proper documents)
  - Refugees (official status)
  - Those who have not applied before (and have not participated in the Erasmus+ program)

# What documents are needed?

- An application including the list of chosen destinations (up to three) with a proper justification for each of them and contact information (telephone number, email).
- Your application should include all information which could possibly be relevant to the committee's decision (e.g. participation in classes held in foreign languages, academic experiences abroad, activity supporting the Faculty or the University, scientific achievements, previous participation in Erasmus+ program).
- If you consider more than one possible destination, you should list them all (up to three) and indicate your preferences. Currently there are 29 universities in our offer.

# What documents are needed?

- An application with proper justification of chosen destination(s) and contact info (phone, email).
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- **The list of all grades received at the Faculty of Philosophy (Philosophy Program or Cognitive Science Program – inclusive „or”)**
- **In the case of MISH/MISMAP students: only grades received in these two programs**
- **At least one recommendadion letter from an employee of the Faculty of Philosophy (in the case of post-graduate student: from the PhD supervisor).**
- **A certificate of foreign language fluency (a result of an exam, a recommendation from a language instructor.; it is candidate’s duty to check what level of fluency is required by the partner institution).**
- The application should be submitted via USOSweb but additionally all the documents should be sent to Anna Szpilowska ([anna.szpilowska@uw.edu.pl](mailto:anna.szpilowska@uw.edu.pl) )

**DEADLINE: 12.03.2023**

# Scholarship Rates

- a) **670 euro** – Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Denmark, Finland, France, Greece, Spain, Ireland, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Luxemburg, Malta, Germany, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Italy;
  - b) **670 euro** – United Kingdom;
  - c) **600 euro** – Bulgaria, Croatia, Czechia, Estonia, Lithuania, Latvia, North Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey, Hungary.

- One can get extra funds (**50 euro** once) to cover the cost of travel  
**Provided that you travel by bus or train;**  
**Or by car, if there are at least 2 travellers inside (so-called car-pooling).**

# Extra Funds

If you're eligible to receive social scholarship at UW, you you can apply for additional 250 euro/month (a special application at BWZ needed).

If you are a handicapped person, you can apply for additional 250 euro/month, after fileing proper documents to BWZ


If you have a Refugee status confirmed by the Office for Foreigners, you can also get additional 250 euro/month.

# Who evaluates the applications?

A three-party committee which includes:

The Mobility Coordinator (Adrian Ziólkowski)

One employee of the administration of the Faculty (Anna Szpilowska)

A Representative of the Student Self-Government (Joanna Szreder)

# Evaluation criteria

- Your GPA acquired in courses required by the study program during the previous year; minimal condition: GPA 3.49 or higher
- Important restriction: if one has more than one conditional entry (or one has to repeat the whole year), one cannot apply for the Erasmus+ scholarship;
- scientific achievements;
- evaluation of the fluency in the relevant foreign language based on the provided documents;
- year of studies (preference towards higher years);
- the correspondence between the chosen destination and student's interests (based on the information provided in the CV and the recommendation by the Faculty Member);
- activities for the Faculty, University and the academic society;
- a recommendation by at least one employee of the Faculty of Philosophy;
- students with „limited chances“ will be preferred (certificate of disability, receiving social scholarship, official refugee status).



# For how long can you go abroad?

The minimal period of mobility in one academic year is 2 months (60 days), the maximal period – 12 months (360 days).

In practice: your mobility should last for one semester or the whole academic year

If you go abroad in the winter semester, usually it is not a problem to extend it (if you feel like it)

„The capital of mobility“ is 12 months for each student (so, in sum, you cannot participate in the Erasmus+ exchange for more than 12 months throughout your studies)

# What to do after qualification?

Deadline for applications: 12.03.2023

The qualification procedure will be completed by 21.03.2023

Once you get the scholarship, you have to complete a language fluency test regarding the language you're about to w systemie Komisji Europejskiej „Online Linguistic Support - OLS”.

If you are a native speaker of the language in question or you are disabled and your disability does not allow you to take the language test, then you do not have to take the test.

# What to do after qualification?

If accepted for the mobility, every qualified student is obliged to sign a scholarship agreement with BWZ personally or by mail. If you do not sign the agreement it can be treated as resignation from the scholarship and the participation in the mobility.

At the day of signing the agreement, a student can have only one conditional pass, and in such a case, in order to be allowed to get a scholarship one needs to get an approval from the Mobility Coordinator.

# Learning Agreement (LA)

- It is your duty to get familiar with courses offered by the University you will visit
- You have to pick up courses you are planning to pass (Table A)
- IMPORTANT: the minimum number of ECTS you need to collect during a semester is **20**
- IMPORTANT: you need to list some courses at UW which you won't attend but they will be more-or-less equivalent to courses attended abroad (Table B) and they will be later treated as passed based on the mobility
- Table B cannot be empty, it can sum up to less ECTS than Table A (but not more!)
- When preparing your LA, you should remember about completing your study programme
- The courses listed in Table A should be somewhat thematically linked to those listed in Table B

# Learning Agreement - more important info

- IMPORTANT: YOU SHOULD NOT put courses which do not end with a grade in your LA (some foreign universities have such courses in their offer)
- Besides information provided in LA, you should provide more detailed information about the classes you take abroad to a proper office at UW o: type of classes (lecture, tutorial, seminar), the number of hours and an English title of the course (because they will be listed on your diploma)
- Your BA or MA seminar can be passed based on any seminar passed during your Erasmus mobility (but it has to be a seminar!)

# Other mobility programs

- CEEPUS - short-term mobility in Central Europe
- BIP - Blended Intensive Programme for Erasmus+; an online seminar + short physical mobility (one-two weeks)
- 4EU+ a new pilot program including the following universities: University of Warsaw, University of Sorbonne, University of Heidelberg, Charles University in Prague, University of Copenhagen and University of Milano; the negotiations regarding the study programmes are ongoing
- SEMP - a program funded by the Swiss government
